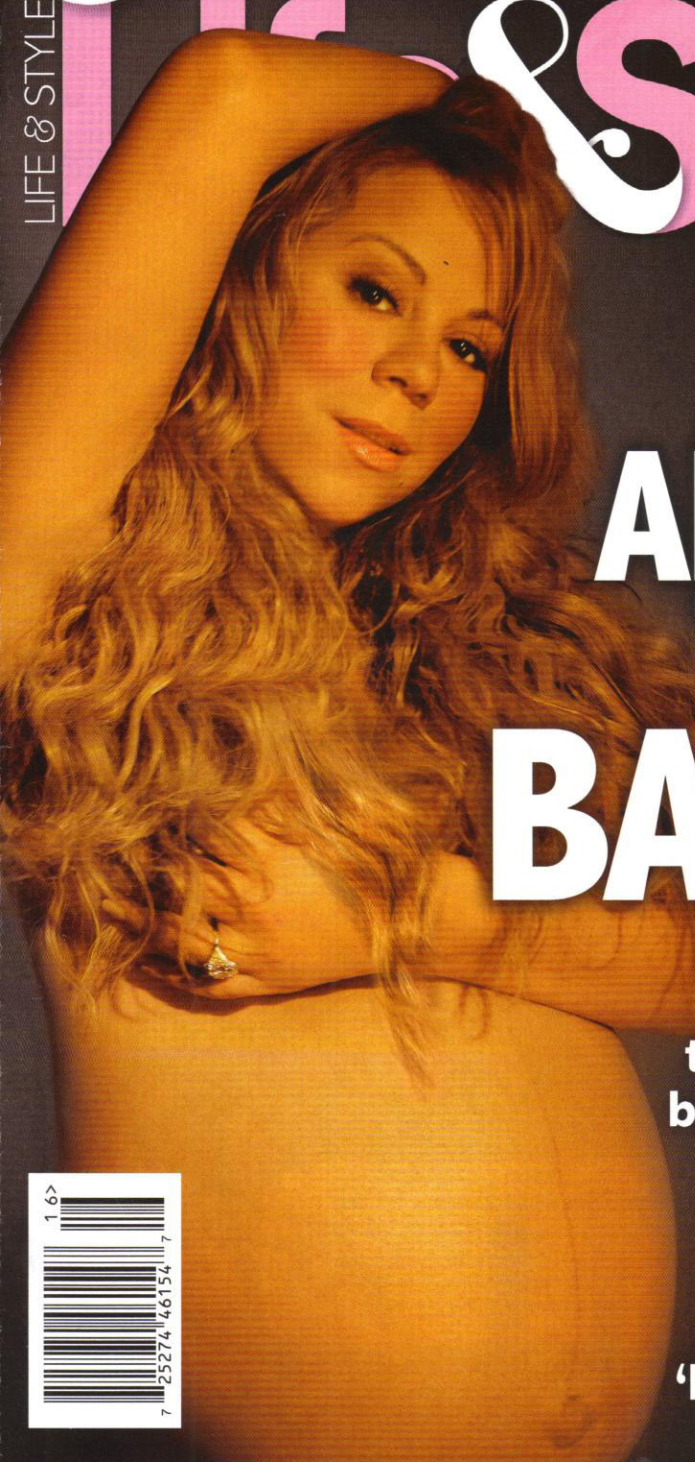

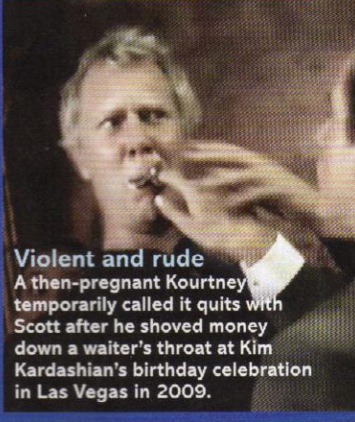


WEDDING CAN WAIT

WHY KOURTNEY WON'T MARRY SCOTT

Kourtney Kardashian puts the brakes on her relationship with baby daddy Scott Disick after he buys an engagement ring

With a Scarselli engagement ring burning a hole in his pocket, Scott Disick nervously waited to pop the question to his girlfriend of 4½ years, Kourtney Kardashian. The love of his life would no doubt flip once she saw the bauble, decked in her favorite yellow pavé diamonds. But Kourt — completely unaware of her guy's intentions — put a halt to Scott's best-laid plans on the April 3 season finale of *Kourtney & Kim Take New York*. "I'm pretty happy with the way things are," she confessed when Scott brought up marriage. "Why mess it up?"

Scott was devastated. "If she accepts my proposal, I'll finally realize all my positive moves are finally paying off," he said before his night turned sour. "[Kourtney's] everything in my world."

That may be precisely the problem. Scott, who quit drinking and entered

counseling after a bloody incident in Miami that left Kourtney in tears in 2010, seems to be pinning his happiness — and possibly his sobriety — on Kourtney. Marriage counselor Carolyn Bushong says that's not healthy and that Scott needs to make lifestyle changes for himself, which in turn will positively affect his family.

Protecting Mason

While Kourt claims she doesn't want to tie the knot because she believes marriage is the kiss of death for a relationship, her hesitation may actually stem from Scott's history of angry outbursts and the fact that he's just a few months into his rehabilitation. "They hit rock bottom in Miami last April, and she gave him an ultimatum: 'Pull yourself together or I'm out,'" says a pal. Until Scott can convince Kourtney that he's committed to keeping his rage in check once and for all, she's showing

she truly has the best interests of their 1-year-old son, Mason, at heart by not entering into a potentially dysfunctional marriage. And sister Khloé doesn't think Kourt will be changing her stance any time soon. "I don't see marriage for any time soon," she tells *Life & Style*. "She never even wanted to get married as a kid."

For now, Kourtney's simply ecstatic to bunk up with her two boys in their new \$1.7 million home in Calabasas, Calif. The absence of a ring on her finger doesn't mean she's not totally in love and excited to see how things will develop with Scott. "She's so proud of the steps he's taken to turn his life around," Kourtney's hopeful for their future," says a friend. "She just isn't in a hurry to walk down the aisle — especially because not even a year has passed since Scott's breakdown in Miami. But at the end of the day, she loves him very much and knows they'll be together forever."

Bloody, drunken tirade
